Art Adventure is a PTO sponsored program that gives parent volunteers the opportunity to teach art and cultural appreciation through classroom lessons and cultural events.

Each school year, every grade will experience

one **cultural event**. Much time has been taken to research various cultures. It is presented as an age appropriate hands on learning experience for the children. Cultural events usually include a history of the culture, music, art and food. The children have the opportunity to taste a sampling of a popular food from the culture. Activities may include an art project, games, presentation from a cultural expert, music and dance. It is
